May I have the permission to present the Annual School Report for the academic session 2019-20, the report documenting its vision, mission and accomplishments.

Result-class X & XII

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of DPS Numaligarh. Class X and XII board results of the school reflect that our students have made us proud with 75 students appearing in class X and 104 students in class XII with 100% results in both class X & XII. In class X, 100% of our students secured first division with 6 students secured perfect 100 percent marks in various subjects. Ankita Bora with 96.8% stood on the top. In class XII, 100 % students passed with first division and 81.7% students scored distinctions. Science stream was topped by Miss Dikshita Hazarika with 95.6% marks, Commerce stream by Miss Tridisha Bharadwaj with 97.4% marks and Humanities stream by Miss Syeda Parsa Nawrin Emani with 98.2%. In class XII, 19 students scored a perfect 100% marks in various subjects compared to 17 of last year. To augment the teaching learning processes, our Principal visited Finland as a member of an Exclusive Learning Mission from 22-27th April 2019 to understand the Finnish Phenomenon and get a 360 degree view of the Finnish Education System, discover new pedagogical approaches for changing stakeholder needs, learn best practices in School Governance and Administration and also learn how to create a culture for innovation in the school ecosystem. The Visit was organized by 'The Learners Confluence (TLC), Bangalore' in association with Koulu Education Group Limited, Finland. As a result of this many innovative ideas have been implemented in the school in the endeavor of making it a Happy School.

Further in order to inculcate a competitive mindset, Olympiads in various subjects are conducted throughout the year along with ASSET diagnostic tests and talent search examinations organized by reputed organizations and the DPS Society.

All this is possible due to the hard work and dedication of our erudite teachers. I am pleased to bring it into record that four of our teachers Mrs Lonu Gogoi, Headmistress, Mr Nivedita Dutta, Mrs Pranab Kumar Singh and Mrs Anindita Baruah have completed 20 long years of dedicated service to this institution, which is truly very commendable. We owe our gratitude to them.

Students' Enrichment Programs

Our earnest endeavor is not only academic excellence but also to motivate and empower our students to be lifelong learners. Through these workshops, activities and talk series our students get exceptional learning opportunities:

DPS Numaligarh, in collaboration with NRL, celebrated the International Yoga day, Vigilance Awareness Week and Hindi Saptah, with mass participation of children at every level.

The School has set up a Wellness Club in the school to sensitize children towards various issues related to Health, hygiene, safety and awareness towards various abuses and sensitiveness towards animals and environment. Our students interacted with IPS Shri L.R. Bishnoi on the topic of 'Substance Abuses' and Ms Anuva Bhuyan on the topic 'Cyber Crime' in the month of October. IPS S.S. Panesar conducted an interactive session on 'Integrity-a way of life'. Ms Brigitte Uttar Kornetzky spoke on the topic Conservation of elephants.

A group of 4 students participated in the Wild Wisdom Quiz North East State Final held in, Guwahati on 1st October, 2019. Our students gave their best and had wide exposure and enriching experience.

A presentation about the entry to the Defense Forces and life style in defense was conducted by Lt Prashant, an officer of 3 Sikh regiment for the students of Classes IX and XI in January 2019.

A field trip was organized to the Jorhat Planetarium in February 2019 to enlighten the students of Class IV on concepts related to the solar system.

In May 2019, the Home Science batch of Class XII visited the VKNRL School of Nursing. Students were introduced to the field of nursing. Students visited the Nutrition Lab, labs equipped with ICU setups.

A group of 160 students of Classes III and IV went for a field trip to Uncle Robin Banerjee Children's Museum, Golaghat in May 2019. They had a glimpse of the charming old artifacts from all over India and abroad, collection of wild photography and dolls. Paintings by the great Jamini Roy, MF Hussain and Rabindranath Tagore adorn the walls.

Another group of 105 students from class V was taken on a field trip to Sukapha Samanny Khetra Mohbondha, Jorhat in May 2019. It is a memorial built in the memory of Sukapha, the founder of the Ahom kingdom which continued to exist for nearly six hundred years. Its art gallery showcases the life and tradition of different tribes of the Northeast.

A group of 34 students from Painting and Psychology departments visited Guwahati Medical College and Kalakendra Museum as a part of their field trip projects as mandated by CBSE.

Overnight educational tours to places of importance are also well integrated with school curriculum to chisel the personalities of our children. A group of 19 boarders and three teachers visited Singapore in the month of August 2019. 43 students each along with three escort teachers each visited city of Pearls, Hyderabad and Delhi, Jim Corbett and city of Lake Nainital respectively in the month of September to enrich their learning experiences.

Besides academics we are well known for our co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. This year we have established a well laid out SOP to conduct these activities in our school covering all levels with all forms of activities with well specified action plan. All these details you will find in our school magazine along with achievement of our children.

A group of nine students participated in the Inter DPS Dance Festival 2019 (Zonal Level) at DPS Nazira on 3rd Aug 2019 organized by DPS Society. The School was awarded with 'Special Appreciation' prize.

East Zone Inter DPS Music Festival was organized on 3rd Aug 2019, by DPS Society at DPS Guwahati. Eight students participated in the event and gained a rich experience.

Sport's achievements & NCC

Strenuous exercise and interest in games is an outlet for the vigor of youth. Ample opportunities are provided to our children to play and prove their mettle in various sports and games meet at school, cluster, regional and national level competitions.

We proudly apprise that our school teams have performed very well at state and national level tournaments. Our Basketball Girls under 14 team qualified for nationals to be held in Delhi. Miss Mindum of class VIII wad declared best player of the tournament. Besides this, our Table Tennis, Taekwondo and Swimming Boys & Girls teams participated in CBSE cluster/zonal tournaments. Miss Mrigakhi Sarma of class VIII qualified for CBSE National Swimming Championship.

Our boys Football team participated in the inter DPS Football tournament in under 14 category held at DPS Nazira.

Master Manan Nath of class VIII is doing very well at state and national tournaments and we expect he represents our country one day.

Nine students from our school qualified for SGFI nationals in Tennis and Swimming events.

The equestrian team of Delhi Public School, Numaligarh participated in the Horse Show and Regional Equestrian League conducted by the Equestrian Federation of Assam in Dibrugarh in April 2019. Our school riders galloped their way to emerge as champions. Andrew William K. From Jorhat Headquarters, Manali Rabha bagged the 1st best cadet while; Sumaiya Shah bagged the 2nd Best Cadet. A scholarship of Rs. 4,500/- and Rs. 3,500/- were awarded to these winners.

Thal Sainik Camp, Inter Unit Firing Competition for NCC cadets of Jorhat Group from 6th to 15th Aug 2019 was held at NCC Academy, Jorhat. All the four cadets were selected for TSC-I Camp and three participated in camp II. Dolly Teranppi of IX Received Best Shooter in this camp under all North-East Region held in Delhi and finally got selected for National Camp. Miss Olimpriya of class IX is in the process of getting in to the Republic Day Parade-2020 to be held at Delhi.

Atal Tinkering Lab

DPS Numaligarh is one of the few schools in India to have set up Atal Tinkering Lab, a project to incubate innovative and creative minds in children initiated by Niti Ayog & HRD Ministry, Govt. of India. have been tinkering with active participation in lab activity based on Electronics and Robotics. We have joined hands with Kaziranga University for various projects and also adopted projects of UNICEF.
