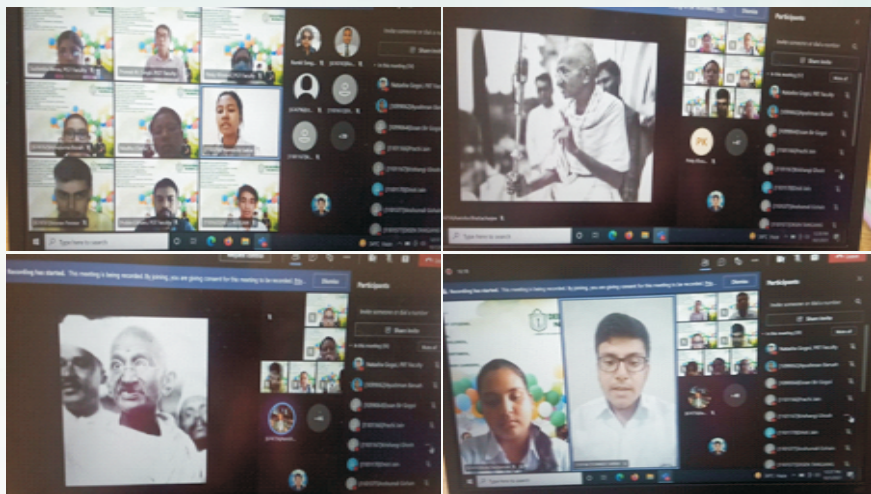




## SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON GANDHI JAYANTI

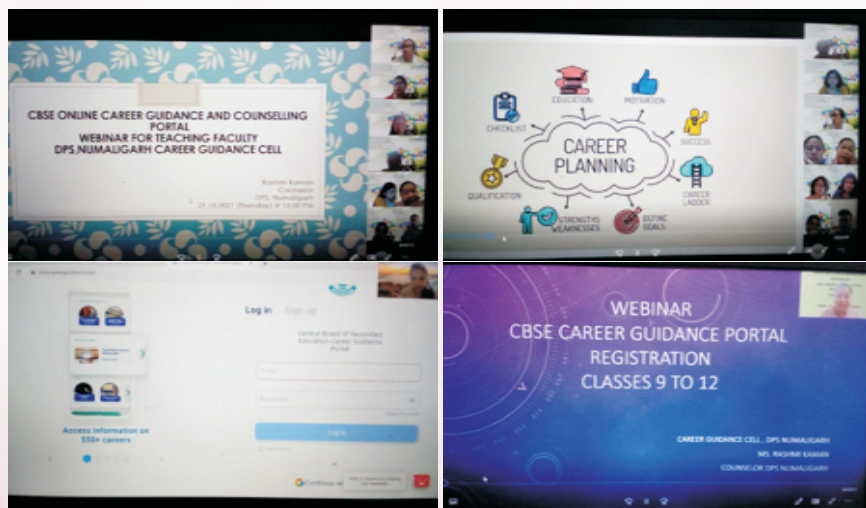

## WEBINAR ON CBSE CAREER GUIDANCE PORTAL

The Career Guidance Cell of Delhi Public School, Numaligarh conducted a webinar on CBSE CAREER GUIDANCE PORTAL for teaching staff and students studying from classes 9 to 12 along with their parents. The webinar was conducted in three phases for different categories - Teachers (21<sup>st</sup> Oct 2021), students studying in classes 11 & 12 (25<sup>th</sup> Oct 2021) across all streams and students studying in classes 9 & 10 (26<sup>th</sup> Oct 2021) all sections.

The webinar was on CBSE Career Guidance portal information and registration procedure which was based on the NEP 2020 for an overhaul of the existing teaching learning patterns, by optimizing learners' academic and vocational capabilities. CBSE, has taken the task for effective implementation of online



portal for Career Guidance and Counselling of class IX-XII students in all affiliated schools in the same context. It has brought a consultative group of experts with UNICEF belonging to industry, academia, and government to prepare the future road map.

This webinar was an initiative to help young people gain knowledge and skills for self-development and to transit smoothly from school to higher education or work. This portal is mobile, tablet and laptop compatible. The portal with the entire career curriculum will be offered to students at no cost. Each student through individual career dashboard will be able to access the

Guidance of Children and also action plans to be prepared by teachers for making students' future ready. Counselor conducted aptitude test for students and along with exploration on their career blue print road map.

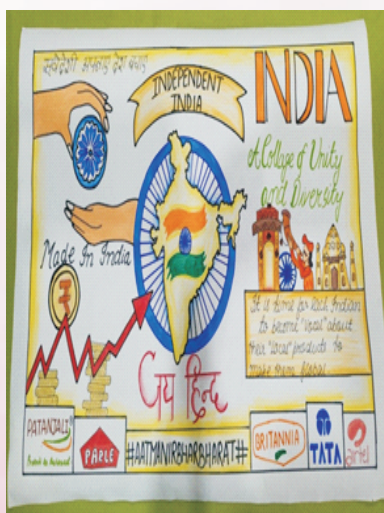

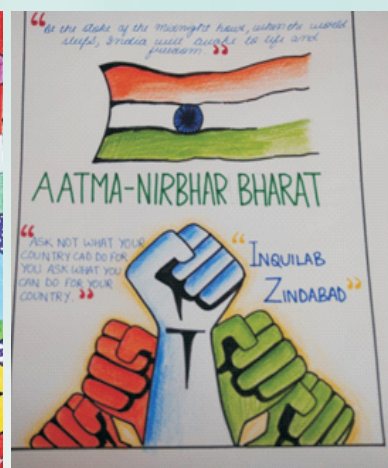
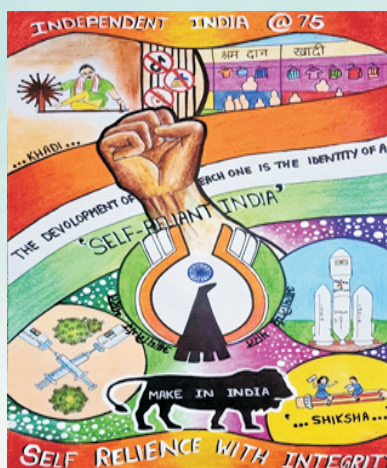

## NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT SURVEY

The Ministry of Education, Government of India has entrusted the responsibility of conducting the National Achievement Survey ( NAS 2021) in 733 districts to the Central Board of Secondary Education(CBSE).NAS is a national-level large scale assessment which provides a comprehensive and authentic database for bringing in qualitative improvement in school education system. NAS-2021 was scheduled on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2021 in the sample schools on a single day to know the learning achievement level of students of grade 3,5,8 and 10.

It was like a cherry on top of the cake moment for Delhi Public School, Numaligarh as Principal, Mr U.C.Harbola on behalf of the School was conferred the responsibility and was appointed as the District Level Co-ordinator

by the Ministry of Education through CBSE to conduct the NAS-2021 in the entire Golaghat district. Our school was also one of the sampled CBSE schools for the survey amongst the other 201 sampled schools in Golaghat district. The survey was conducted in sampled Central Government Schools, State Government Schools, Government

Aided Schools and Private Unaided recognized schools in a monitored environment. A total of 241 observers were appointed from CBSE and State Board schools for the smooth functioning of NAS 2021. The findings of the survey will surely throw light and pave the way for the implementation of the New Education Policy (NEP 2020) .The survey was conducted in an MCQ format .The three hour exam covered subjects like Language, Mathematics , Science and Social Science. The survey tools used were Multiple Choice Questions, Questionnaires



pertaining to students, teachers and the school. The National Achievement Survey(NAS) went off smoothly in Golaghat district while maintaining all COVID- safety norms.

As it has been said, "It is good to have an end to journey towards, but it is the journey that matters, in the end." Delhi Public School, Numaligarh truly



gained goodwill in the district by building camaraderie and accomplishing such a big scale achievement in proving and emerging as one of the Premiere school in the entire North-eastern region. The school has poured heart and soul and left no stones unturned in abiding every minute rules and regulations as envisioned by the Government of India thus creating a history in the golden pages of the school record. NAS 2021 will truly prove to be a rich repository of evidences and data points furthering the scope of qualitative improvement and acting as a guiding star for the implementation of the New Education Policy 2020.

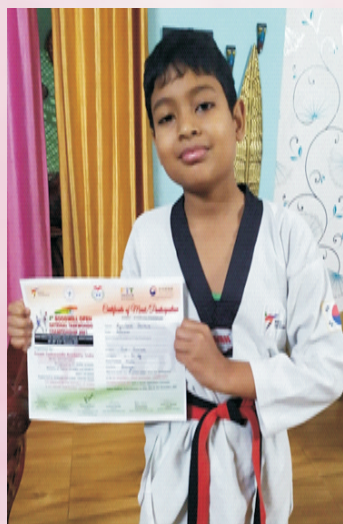


## ACHIEVEMENTS

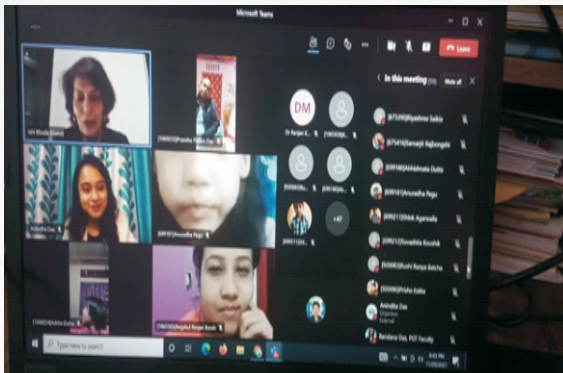




## WEBINAR ON HEALTHY KIDS
