Advances in Control and Optimization of Dynamical Systems or ACODS 2022 was organised by NIT Silchar in collaboration with IIT Guwahati from February 22 to 25, 2022. The aim of ACODS 2022 was to bring together the international community of researchers and practitioners from academia, industry, and research laboratories to disseminate new developments and advances in control and optimization of dynamical systems. Multiple workshops and competitions were held which were mostly for university graduates and undergraduates. A Line-Following-Robot-Making competition was held for schools having ATL Labs. Students from classes 8-12 were eligible and the schools had to nominate at most two teams of at most 5 members each. Our school, Delhi Public School Numaligarh, hosted a team of two students: Abhinava Kalita (10-A) and Abhinab Shreyam Kalita (10-B).

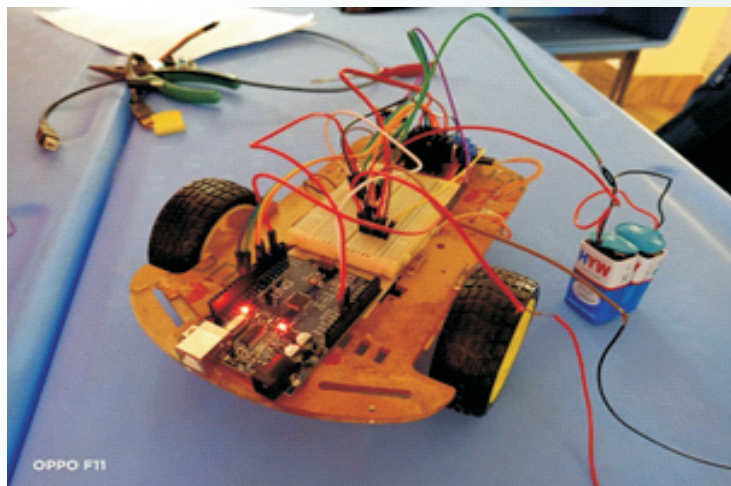
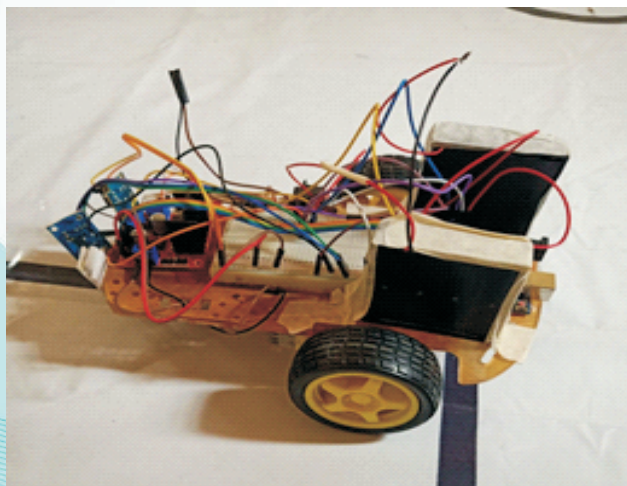
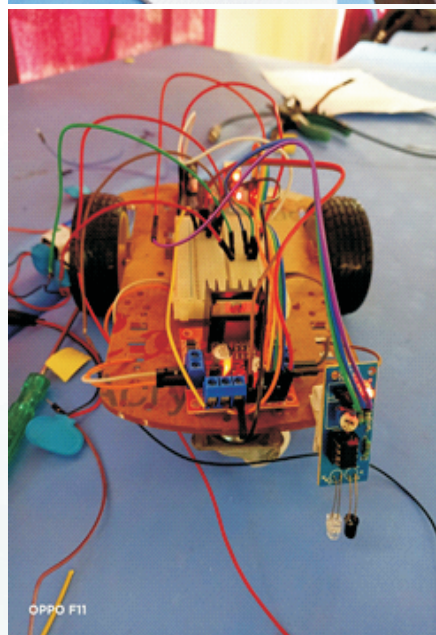
The team did an excellent job and won the second prize.

"We had to build a Line Follower Robot: A car that could move by following a track made with black tape. A half-day workshop was organised on February 12 wherein we were guided by Mr. Achintya Saha, Director, Technomate Edubotics Pvt.Lmt. and taught how to build the robot. We were facing a lot of problems in the beginning but after some research, hard work and guidance from our teacher, Probin Likhari sir, we successfully built the robot.

Out of 19 submissions, 8 teams were selected for Round 2. In round 2, that was held on 23rd February, all the 8 teams showed their models to a jury of 4 in a zoom meeting. It was a nice experience for the team as they learnt, failed, tried again and again and finally came up with a working robot.

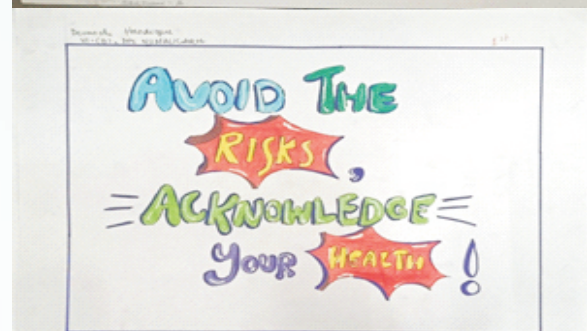
