

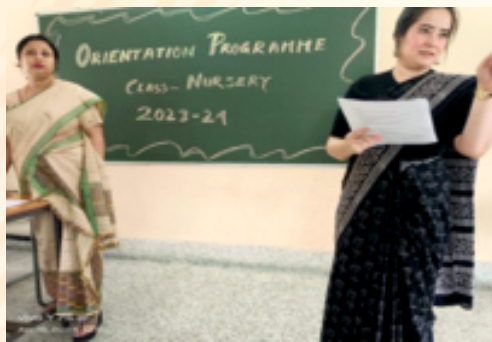


## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

## VISIT OF MAJOR GENERAL GAGAN DEEP, ADG-NCC (NORTH EAST)



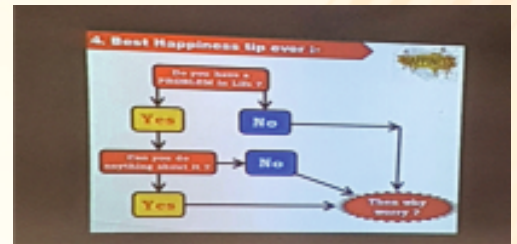

# WORKSHOP ON STRENGTHENING ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION PRACTICES



A two day workshop on Strengthening Assessment and Evaluation Practices was organized by CBSE at Delhi Public School Numaligarh on 29th and 30th May 2023. It started off with an analogy which really touched everyone. The difference between Assessment and Evaluation was clearly explained with the example of a plant. Assessment For, Of and As were explained clearly giving examples highlighting the Periodic tests, Portfolios, Subject Enrichment Activities and Multiple Assessments. Relevant CBSE circulars were distributed highlighting the key elements of the remodelled structure of assessment. Internal assessments and

its structure, LAAR cycle of assessment was discussed briefly laying emphasis on the learning outcomes of Multiple Assessment through SMART. The objectives of SEA and Portfolio with examples were clearly specified with images. Blueprint and typology of question paper, level of questions were discussed based on Bloom's Taxonomy. Question paper were designed in the form of individual and group activities ranging from LOTS to HOTS. It was a wonderful workshop where we got to meet and exchange our ideas with different school teachers pertaining to assessment and evaluation. The resource persons namely Mrs Anupa Harbola and Mr Kulamoni Das meticulously helped the teachers to chalk out a road map for customizing the assessment pattern as per the CBSE curriculum. The main objective of the workshop was to make the participants understand the structure of assessment

and to optimize learning in all students through regular assessment and evaluation. The two day session kept everyone abreast with the latest CBSE changes and circulars. Teachers were given hands on experience making a question paper related to one's own subjects incorporating the LAAR cycle of assessment.

# Innovation, Design, and Entrepreneurship IDE Bootcamp at IIT Guwahati

Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati started the 5-day residential bootcamp programme on **Innovation, Design, and Entrepreneurship (IDE)** from 22nd to 26th June 2023. It was jointly organized by the **Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC)** and the **All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)**.
