Report on the Awareness workshop “Are You Aware?” POCSO Act 2012

An awareness workshop titled "Are You Aware?" was organized on August 24, 2024 by DPS, Numaligarh, to address the POCSO Act of 2012. The Jr. DPSN educators and staff, as well as parents of nursery class students, were the target audience for the program. The school POCSO Committee organized this awareness campaign as part of their ongoing efforts to guarantee that every student is treated with respect and decency at all times. Topics covered in the presentation featured the following:

The program addressed the following subjects:

1. The POCSO Act 2012
2. Teaching Children About Body Safety: Help them identify safe situations.
3. Monitoring Developmental Milestones in Children
4. Forming wholesome routines from solid relationships –
 - a) Handling tantrums and lying
 - b) Child diet,
 - c) Does Your Child's Screen Time Concern You? – Induced Autism/Selective Mutism.
5. Establishing a strong bond with your child
6. A vital educational milestone to reach – Reading and Writing.

This program aimed to provide parents with knowledge concerning the regulations and processes in place at DPS, Numaligarh regarding child sexual abuse. This program was designed to assist parents in developing stronger bonds with their toddlers, educated them on safe and unsafe proximity, protecting their children from abuse, establishing healthy boundaries, and communicating honestly with their child. The awareness drive was additionally intended to assist parents in understanding how they might encourage their child to speak up about abuse, hence reducing long-term implications.

This program also educates parents on how to track developmental milestones for their child. This can assist parents understand their child's growth and spot potential problems early on. Milestones are indicators of excellent health and might include cognitive, physical, and socio-emotional achievements that children reach at various ages. This program also aimed to raise parents' awareness of early reading skills that their children should develop, as these skills will influence a child's future success, including employability and health. Mrs. Lonu Gogoi, Head Mistress; Mrs. Namita Borah, Sr. Mistress; Mrs. Deepika Roy, Elementary Scholar; and Mrs. Rashmi Kaman, School Counselor were the DPSN's POCSO committee's resource people who shared their knowledge with the attendees who actively took the effort to share their knowledge and encourage participants to communicate in both directions during the workshop.

The parents who attended the workshop expressed gratitude and asked to attend similar, more engaging workshops in the future. The committee has considered suggestions and enhancements for upcoming programs based on input from participants on the feedback forms.
