



DPS Numaligarh Fest sparks joy and excitement

PEDAL TO PLANT

The Pedal to Plant event at Delhi Public School Numaligarh took place on 6th November 2025 and featured Ms. Nisha Kumari, a celebrated paracyclist and mountaineer, as both presenter and initiator under the FIT India banner. The initiative, themed “The Ride for the Iron Man of India” to dedicate Shri Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, carried the slogan “Change Before the Climate Change” and was led by renowned Mount Everest Summitier Ms. Nisha Kumari. The core aim of the program is to plant 100,000 trees along the route from Arunachal Pradesh to Gujarat, aligning with the broader FIT India movement to promote physical activity and environmental stewardship.

The event at Delhi Public School Numaligarh was organized as part of the Pedal to Plant initiative, with the ambitious objective of contributing significantly to reforestation while encouraging fitness and active participation among students. Ms. Kumari emphasized in her address that nothing is impossible in life and that every aim is achievable, urging students to set high goals and persevere. She highlighted the importance of regular physical activity and sports participation, and encouraged engagement in environmental action through tree planting and related conservation efforts. The speech underscored a balanced approach to aspiration and participation, noting that while aiming high is commendable, practical and inclusive involvement in physical activities is essential.

In terms of impact, students and attendees expressed motivation to pursue personal goals and adopt more fitness-based routines, while the environmental objective

of planting 100,000 trees was presented as an aspirational target to be pursued through ongoing community action and collaboration with partner organizations. Looking ahead, there are plans to develop a school-level action plan to participate in the Pedal to Plant initiative, including organizing local tree-planting drives, and to establish a student club focused on fitness and environmental stewardship to sustain activities. Collaboration with local environmental groups is also envisaged to map feasible tree-planting sites along nearby routes and schools, with progress tracked through visible milestones and celebrated for small wins to maintain momentum. Overall, the initiative successfully integrated fitness, environmental awareness, and public service within the school setting, resonating with students and reinforcing the value of perseverance and goal-setting.

The **Holistic Progress Card (HPC)** is a transformative assessment tool introduced in line with India's **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**. It marks a significant shift away from traditional, summative assessments that primarily test rote memorization and academic marks. Instead, the HPC adopts a **360-degree, multidimensional** approach to evaluate a student's complete development.

In partnership with NCERT's PARAKH the Human Resource Development Centre of The Delhi Public School Society organised a two day residential training workshop on 8-9 October, 2025 to help educators understand the philosophy of the HPC and to support effective implementation from Nursery through Grade VIII. Mrs Lonu Gogoi, Headmistress, DPS Numaligarh was privileged to be invited to attend the workshop.
