### **Brief about the School:**

We are a non-profit educational institution under the aegis of Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), NR Complex, Numaligarh and managed by Delhi Public School Society, Delhi.

Nestling in the sylvan environs of the Brahmaputra valley where the beautiful rendezvous of water and land throws up myriad colours, Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), which was set up at Numaligarh in the district of Golaghat (Assam) in accordance with the provisions made in the historic Assam Accord signed on 15th August 1985, has been conceived as a vehicle for speedy industrial and economic development of the region.

The 3 MMTPA Numaligarh Refinery Limited was dedicated to the nation by the erstwhile Hon'ble Prime Minister Late Shri A. B. Vajpayee on 9th July 1999. NRL has been able to display creditable performance since the commencement of commercial production in October 2000. With its concern, commitment and contribution to socio-economic development of the state combined with a track record of continuous growth. Currently as per the vision of our Hon'ble Prime Minister and

Honorable Chief Minister NRL is undergoing a mega expansion of its capacity from 3 to 9 MMTPA. It is one of the biggest investments in North-East ever till date.

Delhi Public School, Numaligarh, was established in the year 1997. The prestigious Delhi Public School, Numaligarh, is situated inside the NRL Township premise has already made a mark as an educational institute to reckon with. Affiliated to the CBSE, the School imparts quality education for students from Nursery to Class XII. Apart from academics, the school pays special attention to identify and nurture latent talents amongst its students and steer them in the right direction. The building consisting of 22 new classrooms was constructed with the expansion of the school in mind as skyrocketing demands for the opportunity to study in DPS Numaligarh has necessitated this valuable addition to the campus.

To accommodate the growing number of students and to provide more personalized attention, we have introduced two new sections this year, along with a new section in Class XI (Science). ### **Academic Achievements:**

Delhi Public School Numaligarh students have yet again, showcased their academic excellence by achieving brilliant results in the CBSE board examinations. This year, we are truly honored to announce that our school has achieved an impressive feat with plenty of students scoring 90% and above. These results are a testament to the tireless efforts of our students, and the support and dedication from our teachers. 120 students appeared in class X, and 119 students in XII. We are thrilled to announce that 117 students in class X scored first division, and 30 students scored above 90%. Neha Haloi stood on top with 98.2%.

Moving on to class XII, 118 students passed with first division while 34 students scored above 90%. Gargi Gogoi topped the Humanities stream with 96.8%, Chandaditya Baruah topped the Science stream with 93.2%, while Sakshi Agarwalla and Akshita Bagaria, both topped the Commerce stream with 96.2%. 11 students in class 12 scored 100 marks in various subjects such as Geography, Painting, Business Studies, Political Science, and Psychology. 5 students from class 10 scored a 100 in Assamese, AI, and Mathematics.

We are delighted to welcome 6 new faculty members who have joined our DPSN family this year. The year 2025 witnessed outstanding performances by our students across multiple CBSE-organized events and inter-school competitions, reflecting the dedication and caliber of our sports program. In the CBSE Inter-Cluster Tennis, the FEZ Tennis event held from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August 2025 at DPS Numaligarh saw participation from 28 teams, with our competitors competing valiantly among a strong field, where our boy’s under-14 team qualified for CBSE Nationals by securing topmost position of the tournament. In the CBSE Cluster-1 Table Tennis tournament at Royal Global School, Guwahati, from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025, our Girls Under-14 team earned the position of Second Runner-Up, showcasing solid depth in our junior table tennis squad and commendable performances across rounds. The CBSE Cluster-1 Badminton Tournament, hosted at DPS Dibrugarh from 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> August 2025, saw Aradhya and Jyotishna securing qualification for the CBSE National, underscoring the strength of our Under-17 badminton players and our program’s ability to nurture top contenders. At the national level, the CBSE National Tennis Tournament held at Rishikul Vidyapeeth, Sonipat, from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, witnessed Anchit Dutta achieving the Second Runner-Up position in the Mixed Doubles event, highlighting our school’s competitive tennis stature on a national platform.
