To give a visual representation of place value of 6- digit numbers.	*Children in a group of 4 will use arrow number cards to form a given 6- digit number and find out the place values of different digits in the numeral. Also, they will represent the number on the place value chart. Students will be evaluated on the basis of their performance and representation.
August2026	Knowing Prime and Composite numbers.	To find the prime and composite numbers from 1 to 100.	* Children will write numbers from 1- 100 and use the Seive of Eratosthenes method to encircle the prime numbers and cross out the composite numbers. Students will be evaluated on the basis of concept, correct identification and presentation .
November2026	Geometry of a circle.
